

## PARK ROAD MONTESSORI SCHOOL LEADERSHIP TEAM

The membership of the School Leadership Team (SLT) consists of the principal, the assistant principal, five staff members, and six parent members. With the exception of the PTO rep and the principal, all other members are elected by the school community and serve a term of 3 years. The committee works with the main purpose of developing and implementing the School Improvement Plan (SIP). In this document, we look at all aspects such as student achievement, parent involvement and Montessori pedagogy. Although the SLT is not directly involved in the day-to-day operations of the school, it is involved in a number of tasks that affect the operation of the school (i.e. school safety, two-way communication, etc).

The SIP is the guiding document for our school. We review it annually to ensure that Park Road is on track for success and improvement for all children. We also monitor the plan throughout the year so that we, as an SLT, are meeting the needs of the staff, students and parents.

We typically meet once a month at 7:30 AM in the media center unless there is a specially scheduled meeting.
